What to Expect | How to Prepare

1. Please register [HERE](#) for worship. A confirmation email will be sent to you from Fransine Villasenor, Office Manager. If your plans change and you are unable to attend in person, please let us know by leaving a message with Fransine. Thanks!
2. The Sanctuary, Welcome Center, and all hallways will be thoroughly sanitized prior to and following each service.
3. Bring and wear your mask! We'll have extras available. Masks must be worn at all times. Volunteers and staff will also be masked.
4. Please use the front doors unless the wheelchair lift is needed. If it's raining, please use the winter entrance.
5. Your temperature will be taken before you enter. Anyone with a fever above 100.4°F will be asked to worship online instead.
6. Hand sanitizer will be available in the Welcome Center and you will be asked to use it prior to entering the Sanctuary.
7. Seating will be directed by ushers so that we are socially distanced.
8. There will be no congregational singing or recitation (except in a whispered tone or humming).
9. Exiting will be done one row at a time beginning in the rear of the Sanctuary.
10. There will be no food, coffee, or gathering in the Welcome Center following the service. If you wish to congregate following the service, please do so outside.
11. The restroom off the play area will be open for use and sanitized after each use.
12. The nursery will be available with prior registration only for children 4 and under. Please contact Jane Roscoe at children@fpcnapa.org to determine availability. For families who would like to worship together, activity bags will be available for kids to use during worship and take home.
13. Kids' Church will continue to meet online at 11:15 a.m. on Zoom. Please email Jane Roscoe at children@fpcnapa.org for the link to join in.
